

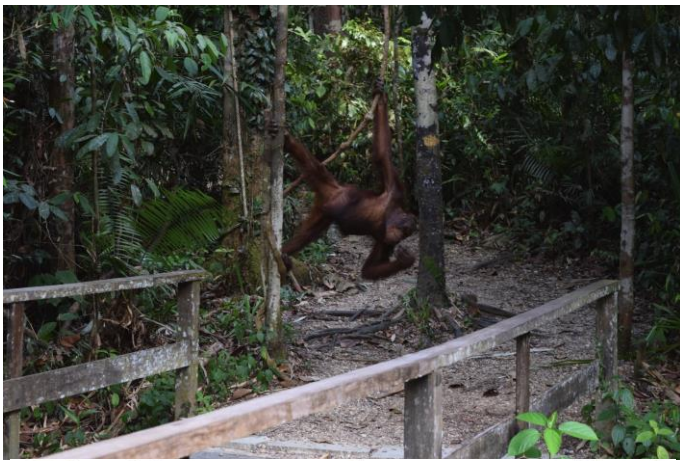

Planting more trees practical way to combat global warming

KUCHING: One of the most practical ways of combating global warming and reducing our carbon footprint is to plant more trees.

"We have planted probably more than 250,000 trees over the span of more than 20 years (in Sarawak)," said director of Japan-Malaysia Association (JMA) T Arakane during the Garden City tree planting ceremony at Kuching South City Council (MBKS) yesterday.

"JMA is a non-profit organisation, we are not looking

for any profit, we just plant trees and if this can help the people, we are already very happy."

Meanwhile, coordinator of JMA in Sarawak Kazuo Sakai said the trees planted by JMA were all locally diminishing species such

According to her, just yesterday, JMA yet again planted 280 indigenous tree species at Gunung Apeng Forest Reserve.

During the ceremony, the 18-member Japanese delegation aged between nine and 77 added eight Foxtail palm trees to the lively garden at MBKS.

"We planted trees in DBKU (Kuching North City Hall) before but this is our first time planting trees in MBKS. We would like to contribute in promoting Kuching as a garden city," said Sakai. MBKS secretary John Lee Hock Kong who was representing mayor Dato James Chan, MBKS staff, president of Sarawak Judo Association (SJA) Francis Chan and members of SJA were present.
